



The story

The jumper is worn by all players of the Jandakot Jets Junior FC.

Jandakot meaning "place of the whistling eagle", is represented through 2 parts on this jumper, firstly through the waterways in which is painted through the black lines and the brown connecting circles, secondly, through the whistling eagle which you will see soaring across both sides of the jumper.

The players are represented at the bottom front of the jumper, they are depicted sitting around a meeting place, this is their local home ground and painted in the red colour of the jets, the red connecting dots are where the players travel to other grounds and the orange dots represent the oponents grounds.

Finally, the boomerang in the centre of the jumper represents the original V of the jets traditional jumpers, this is representing the heart and sole of the footy club, inside the boomerang you will find people meeting, this represents the committee members, volunteers, and supporters of the footy club, the dots going up the boomerang represents what all these people bring to the Jandakot Jets Football Club.


