Thanks to all who contributed content and photos.</p> <p>I note that the 2022 Yearbook has been removed from the website; I think it would be great to keep it on the website as a reference for years to come.</p> <p>Registrations 2024</p> <p>I have set up the registration forms for juniors and Auskick, including fees agreed on by the committee. A 10% family discount applies to juniors (for additional family members providing the same email address is used) – does not apply to Auskick. Kidsport vouchers doubled to be \$300.</p> <p>Please note that registrations are set to open on the 1st November. 	<p>The following fees for 2024 apply (but can be changed): Auskick: \$130 (Club receives 50% of fees) Year 3 to Year 6 Junior (male and female) Registration Fee - \$220 Year 7 to Year 10 Youth (male and female) Registration Fee - \$250 Year 11/12 Youth (female) Registration Fee - \$260 Year 11/12 Youth (male) Registration Fee - \$300 Player Development Levy = \$16.50 paid directly to the WAFC Please note, when new players registrar, certain committee members will receive an automatic notification; and for new players only, each will need to be approved – by going in to PlayHQ, selecting the 2024 competition>participants and then filtering for ‘pending’. This will be required for all Year 3s coming from Auskick or elsewhere, as well as any other player who is playing junior football for the first time. Transfers in will result in the registrar being notified – and you will need to go in to ‘Transfers & Permits’ and they will need to be approved. You can set ‘transfers out’ to be automatically approved. Please note that the transfer period commences on 1st February.</p> <p>Season Permits – these will need to be organised for Colts and Rogers players – otherwise players not falling into this category should be permitted from JJJFC to WAFL district (e.g. futures).</p> <p>Game tallies Jackie and I have created a game tally spreadsheet for all players in the club – this is because PlayHQ are not able to include missing games from the transfer to PlayHQ from SportsTG – this affects a small number of current and former players. Hopefully this is rectified into the future.</p> <p>Honour Board I have requested that the Honour Board is updated by Ron - Inglis Industries 150 game players (2023) – Riley Dawe, Vian Irani, Rhyder James, Riley Walker 200 games – Renee Morgan Life Members (2023) – Shane Ford / Tabitha Bond Club Persons (2023) – Jackie Sutherland / Gary Vincent Life Member (2022) – move Warren Littlefair from 2021 to 2022 2024 Best of luck to the committee for 2024, if I can be of any help, please feel free to reach out.
